1. <u>Dedication Celebration</u> - Bishop Crosby has confirmed that the Solemn Blessing and Dedication of our new Holy Cross Church will take place on **SUNDAY, FEBRUARY 13th, 2011** at **3:00 p.m.** Further schedule details relating to our move will be announced in the coming weeks.

2. <u>Office relocation</u> - Our parish offices will be moving to the new Holy Cross Church during the Christmas break. We anticipate opening the new office on **Monday**, **January 3rd**. The current office will close on Friday, December 17th. Phone lines will be transferred to the new site on December 20th. Messages will be picked up daily. Your patience and understanding during this transition will be greatly appreciated.
