ON THE WAY TO BETHLEHEM

Please join us Friday, Saturday, Sunday or Monday, November 30th, December 1st, December 2nd & December 3rd from 6:30 p.m. to 9:00 p.m. each evening for the eleventh year of "On the Way to Bethlehem." Adults \$5 each, no charge for children. Country Heritage Park, 8560 Tremaine Road, just west of Milton and south of Hwy. 401."On the Way to Bethlehem" is an outdoor Nativity pageant.
