Baptism - Infants and young children of parishioners are baptized on Sunday afternoons, except during the Season of Lent. Adults requesting baptism, or the other sacraments of initiation should inquire about the RCIA (Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults). Contact the Parish Office for more information.

Marriage - Weddings for parishioners are generally celebrated on Saturday afternoons. Kindly contact the Pastor a minimum of one year before the desired date of marriage. Preparation is provided in the Parish.

Arrangements can be made for the *Sacrament of the Sick* and for *Holy Communion*. From the Pastor's Desk

November is always a traditional time to pray for all the faithful departed. It was great to see so many people attend our All Souls day Masses, and we will continue to pray for our deceased loved ones all month long in a particular way.

It's also traditional for the parish to have you enter names of your deceased loved ones into our 'Book of Life', but due to pandemic protocols we will be doing that differently this year. To avoid the unnecessary touch points of shared pens, we will have a basket available in the narthex for you to place the names that you wish to have prayed for. Write the names on a piece of paper at home, and then drop that pieces of paper in the basket the next time you come to Mass.

A couple of other parish traditions for November will also not be possible this year. We have always hosted a special Mass for all those that have passed away in the parish during the past year, as well as offering prayers at the Georgetown cemeteries. In regards to the special Mass, we will postpone that this year until we are all able to freely gather again. Because of capacity restrictions we don't want to invite family members to the Mass and then have to turn them away should the church fill up. We will continue to pray for our deceased loved ones at our Masses in November, and we hope we can celebrate this memorial Mass in the spring — God willing — hopefully not having to worry about capacity regulations.

It has also been a tradition to offer prayers at the local cemeteries. However, also due to pandemic restrictions we won't be able to do that this year as a parish group. Outdoor gathering limits in Ontario are 25 people, and we would have no way of being able to control the number of people that may join us. I know it seems strange that we have to worry about outdoor gathering numbers, but that is the law and could risk us being assessed significant fines for not abiding by the rules. Having said that, Fr. Hayden and I will make a point of offering prayers at Greenwood, Holy Redeemer and Glen Williams cemeteries privately throughout the month and encourage you to do the same. There is an indulgence available for this practise, which is outlined below in this bulletin.

Religious Instruction for Public School Students

Parents of children enrolled in <u>Public</u> or <u>Private</u> schools are invited to enroll them in our parish's religious instruction program. The lessons are home-based and children work at their grade level and their own pace. It is sponsored by the Diocese of Hamilton and administrated through our parish. The successful completion of the appropriate Grade Levels is **required** prior to the child's reception of the sacraments. For example a child in Grade 2 should have completed the Level 1 program and be enrolled in Level 2. A child preparing for Confirmation should have completed all levels (and enrolled in Level 7) prior to Confirmation. For more information and registration kindly contact the Parish Office.
