

H1N1 FLU PRECAUTIONS

This past summer Bishop Tonnos offered several recommendations regarding precautions to be observed in light of the concerns regarding the spread of the H1N1 flu virus.

- If you are sick you need not attend Sunday Mass. There is no obligation to attend Mass if you are ill.
- 2. The Bishop recommends that those who normally receive Holy Communion on the tongue now receive it *in the hand* so as to lessen the possibility of transmission. The option remains that of the person receiving Communion.
- 3. That proper hand washing techniques be observed by all. Parishioners may wish to avoid shaking hands. The *Sign of Peace* need not be a hand shake. One may simply bow and wish the "Peace of Christ" to one's neighbours.
- 4. Communion from the cup is suspended during this time. We do, however, have some parishioners who suffer from an allergy to wheat gluten. These individuals do receive Holy Communion from the cup.
- 5. Hand sanitizing stations have been set up in the "Ushers' Room" (off the main entrance) and at each entrance of the *Chapel*.

Your kind cooperation with these simple recommendations is encouraged and gratefully appreciated.




