SYRIAN REFUGEE RELIEF FUND

The Canadian Conference of Catholic Bishops (CCCB) has endorsed a joint campaign aimed at involving all the Church in Canada to assist Syrian refugees. This campaign involves the Canadian Catholic Organization for Development and Peace, Aid to the Church in Need (ACN) and CNEWA Canada. The Government of Canada announced on September 12th it has established the Syrian Refugee Relief Fund. Every eligible dollar donated by individual Canadians to registered Canadian charities in response to the impact of the conflict in Syria will be matched by the government for up to \$100 million. Donations should be made to "Holy Cross Parish." All donations marked with your name and address will be recorded for income tax receipts. Donations need to be received at the parish office by Friday October 23rd to be forwarded to the Diocese of Hamilton to qualify for the fund matching.

BAPTISMS AT HOLY CROSS PARISH

The Sacrament of Baptism is celebrated with children when at least one parent is a Catholic. Parents and godparents are called to take up the practice of the faith if this has been lacking. You are the "first teachers" of your children in the faith and we pray that you will be the best of teachers! For serious family reasons, permission may be given for Baptism to be celebrated in another Catholic parish, or to celebrate Baptism with families from outside our parish. Arrangements for Baptism can be made before the child is born. We ask new parents to participate in a Baptism Preparation Meeting (generally the first Thursday of each month). It would be fine to participate in this meeting before the child is born. Godparents are welcome to attend the meeting if they are able. A "godparent" is a fully initiated Roman Catholic meaning that they are baptized, confirmed and regularly practising their Catholic faith. Baptized non-Catholics may act as a Christian Witness along with a Catholic godparent.

2016 WEDDINGS

Couples planning to marry in 2016 should contact the parish office. Kindly note that we require one year's notice of marriage to allow time for marriage preparation and the completion of the necessary documents. This requirement also applies to couples from Georgetown who are planning marriage outside the Diocese of Hamilton.
