Adults requesting baptism, or the other sacraments of initiation should inquire about the RCIA (Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults). Contact the Parish Office for more information.

*Marriage* - Weddings for parishioners are generally celebrated on Saturday afternoons. Kindly contact the Pastor a minimum of one year before the desired date of marriage. Preparation is provided in the Parish.

*Sacrament of the Sick* - Visits to the sick, either at home or in hospital, can be made by contacting the Parish Office. Arrangements can be made for the *Sacrament of the Sick* and for *Holy Communion*. If you are admitted to the Georgetown Hospital please be sure to identify yourself as a "Catholic" at the time of admission.

#### From the Pastor's Desk

The parish continues to roll along, and we continue to do what we are able to do. Regular Masses, baptisms, 1<sup>st</sup> Communions, Weddings and Funerals are keeping us remarkably busy despite the pandemic restrictions! We are also starting our RCIA program (via Zoom video conference meetings) with 5 candidates who will be exploring the Catholic faith. Keep them in your prayers as we look to Easter of 2021 to receive them fully into the faith!

It is encouraging that parish life continues, but we can't help but notice the news that the COVID case numbers keep creeping up each day. Know that we continue to take seriously our responsibility to keep everyone safe, and we remain vigilant with our protocols — mandatory wearing of masks; social distancing; hand sanitizing; and disinfecting of pews, door handles and washrooms following every Mass or gathering. We are open for worship, but have also temporarily ceased all in-person meetings where the risk of spread is greater. Proactively, we continue to add content daily to our Facebook and Youtube pages to keep you all connected, whether you're comfortable attending in person or not. We will keep doing this until this time of pandemic is well within

our rear view mirror. Most importantly, we are keeping everyone in prayer, and ask for your prayers as well! Have a good week everyone! – Fr. Dave

#### <u>Combined Special Collection – October 17/18</u>

#### **Mass Attendance Statistics**

For your information, here are the statistics for average Sunday Mass attendance since the beginning of September:

5:00pm - 144 7:30am - 61 (no music) 9:00am - 85 10:30am - 124 12:00pm - 142 TOTAL - 555

For those wanting to come to Mass but are worried about the crowds, the 7:30am & 9:00am are a good option, as are weekday Masses that average between 50-60 people. Our inchurch capacity with protocols in place is 150. We also have overflow capacity in the Parish Centre with a camera feed for about 50 people in case we need it, or for those that just feel more comfortable being away from the main crowd in the church. As a comparison, when we did an attendance count in September of 2019, we counted 1337. This decrease is of course understandable given our current circumstances, and we continue to offer the Mass online each Sunday which is averaging between 400-500 views each week, so even if you're not at church, we know you're still out there! We offer these numbers and analysis for your information as many have been asking 'where we're at'. We are happy that you are staying connected to the parish in-person or online, and look forward to the day when we are all able to gather again together as a parish community!

Until last week, you were able to view the parish Facebook page without having a Facebook account. It seems that Facebook has changed the rules, and now requires you to have an account to view content on their platform. Since I cannot at this moment
receive You sacramentally,
come at least spiritually into my heart.
I embrace You as if You are already there and unite
myself wholly to You.
Never permit me to be separated from You. Amen.

#### **Religious Instruction for Public School Students**

Parents of children enrolled in <u>Public</u> or <u>Private</u> schools are invited to enroll them in our parish's religious instruction program. The lessons are home-based and children work at their grade level and their own pace. It is sponsored by the Diocese of Hamilton and administrated through our parish. The successful completion of the appropriate Grade Levels is **required** prior to the child's reception of the sacraments. For example a child in Grade 2 should have completed the Level 1 program and be enrolled in Level 2. A child preparing for Confirmation should have completed all levels (and enrolled in Level 7) prior to Confirmation. For more information and registration kindly contact the Parish Office.
