## Sacramental Information

*Baptism* - Infants and young children of parishioners are baptized on Sunday afternoons, except during the Season of Lent. Adults requesting baptism, or the other sacraments of initiation should inquire about the RCIA (Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults). Contact the Parish Office for more information.

*Marriage* - Weddings for parishioners are generally celebrated on Saturday afternoons. Kindly contact the Pastor a minimum of one year before the desired date of marriage. Preparation is provided in the Parish.

*Sacrament of the Sick* - Visits to the sick, either at home or in hospital, can be made by contacting the Parish Office. Arrangements can be made for the *Sacrament of the Sick* and for *Holy Communion*. If you are admitted to the Georgetown Hospital please be sure to identify yourself as a "Catholic" at the time of admission.

## **WEDDINGS FOR 2013**

If you, or someone you know, wishes to celebrate marriage in Holy Cross Parish in 2013 we are now taking reservations for the FALL of 2013. Please note that the parish requires one (1) year's notice of marriage so that the necessary components of marriage preparation can be completed. Kindly contact the parish office for more information. Dates for 2014 are also being accepted. Weddings are normally celebrated on Saturdays, however, Friday afternoons are also available. In Canada, weddings may not be celebrated on Sundays. Catholics are required by Church Law to be married by a priest and two witnesses.

In the month of September we had 3,120 registered households, from that number 689 registered parishioners made donations through Sunday offering envelopes or pre-authorized debits. The bulk of the parish's income in September (64.41%) was donated by 29.5% of donations. In actual numbers this means that the bulk of our income was contributed by 229 donations of \$20 or more per week. Those giving under \$10 per week totalled 11.24% of all contributions. We are making a great improvement in the financial support of the parish and we continue to be grateful to all who generously support the parish financially. Anyone not currently using offering envelopes or pre-authorized debits is asked to consider committing to this form of financial support for the parish. All donations through offering envelopes or pre-authorized debits are given an annual receipt for income tax purposes. Parishioners who are currently giving, and are gainfully employed or have a steady income, may consider increasing the amount of their weekly donation. Even a small increase will have a big impact for the parish community. For example if you are currently giving \$5 per week, consider increasing that amount to \$7.50 or \$10.
