MESSAGE FROM FATHER CULL

Fall Faith Enrichment Series . . . As I have done in the past, I plan to offer 2 sessions this fall to help us grow in our faith. I will be focusing on the thoughts of Cardinal Basil Hume who, until his death in 1999, was the Cardinal Archbishop of Westminster and a monk of Ampleforth Abbey in Great Britain. I will be drawing special attention to his teachings on prayer which I think are among the best I have read. The sessions will be offered on the following dates: Tuesday November 3 at 11:00 a.m. or Wednesday November 4 at 7:00 p.m., and Tuesday November 10 at 11:00 a.m. or Wednesday November 11 at 7:00 p.m. (PLEASE NOTE THE DATE CHANGE - 2 SESSIONS ONLY - NO OCTOBER SESSIONS). All are welcome.

Projector and Screens - Information Session

I am delighted that we now have a projector and screen installed in Cote Hall. On Coffee Sundays, I look forward to highlighting various community events. I also plan to use the equipment for my upcoming presentations on the teachings of Cardinal Hume next month. I encourage the various parish groups who gather in the hall to avail themselves of this technology.

For many months I have been praying and thinking about how I can make the proclamation of the Gospel and the homily more engaging. While hearing the message is one thing, having some images to connect with is another way of enhancing the message. With the unanimous support of the Pastoral Advisory Council, I am looking at installing projectors and screens in the church. Please know that this will not take away from the aesthetic beauty of the church. As is the case in the hall, the 2 projectors would be mounted from the ceiling and the screens would be mounted on either side of the outer edge of the sanctuary, neither obstructing the image of Jesus the High Priest nor the stained glass windows. The screens would be operated by a remote and would only be lowered during Holy Mass as an aid to my preaching. My intention is not to bombard you with images but to offer perhaps 5 to 10 images in the course of the homily to help the message resonate more fully.

Please know that Cameron Atkins of Alectro Systems Inc. will be presenting how the technology would be used in the church. All are welcome to attend his presentation in the church on Tuesday, October 27th at 7:30 p.m. Cameron installed the projector and screen in the hall and I am very pleased with the work he has done.
