NEW BISHOP OF HAMILTON

On Friday, September 24th, Pope Benedict XVI accepted the resignation of the Most Reverend Anthony F. Tonnos as Bishop of Hamilton. Bishop Tonnos celebrated his 75th birthday on August 1st. Bishops submit their resignation on or near their 75th birthday. We wish Bishop Tonnos well in retirement and thank him for his generous service to the priests, deacons, religious and lay faithful of the Diocese of Hamilton for the past 26 years as our Diocesan Bishop.

The Pope appointed the Most Reverend Douglas Crosby, OMI - until now the Bishop of Cornerbrook, Newfoundland - as the 9th Bishop of the Diocese of Hamilton. We welcome Bishop Crosby and pray for him as he takes on this new role as our chief shepherd in this local Church. Bishop Crosby will be installed at the Cathedral of Christ the King on Monday, November 8th, 2010.

The Diocese of Hamilton was founded in 1856 and includes Halton Region. Our Diocese is home to more than 560,000 Catholics and it is a rapidly growing and vibrant faith community. There are 125 parishes and 30 mission Church served by nearly 200 priests.


