BISHOP'S INSTALLATION

Our new Bishop, the Most Reverend Douglas Crosby, will be installed as the 9th Bishop of Hamilton on Monday, November 8th at the Cathedral of Christ the King, Hamilton. Bishop Crosby becomes our Diocesan Ordinary by the presentation of the Papal Bulla or letter of appointment and then by taking his seat or *cathedra*. He will be led to the cathedra by Archbishop Collins, the Metropolitan Archbishop of Toronto. From November 8th onward we will hear Bishop Crosby's name mentioned in the memento of the Eucharistic Prayer at Mass immediately after the name of the Holy Father. These names are remembered at every Mass as a sign of our communion with Catholics around the world. The Bishop of a Diocese is the chief Shepherd, Leader and Priest of the local Church. He is a spiritual father and brother to the priests and a loving shepherd for God's people. Let us pray for Bishop Crosby as he takes up his ministry among us.
