#### **MESSAGE FROM FATHER CULL**

On the commitment to young people...

As I mentioned in the homily this past weekend, we have about 450 young people in grades 7 and 8 in the four parish elementary schools and another 1500 at Christ the King Catholic Secondary School. As a way of reaching out to these young people and encouraging them to worship and make their home with us, I intend to hire a Youth Minister on a part-time basis for about 10 hours per week. This individual, preferably in his or her 20's, would be someone who can engage young people and is committed to loving and serving the Lord. It is my hope that young people would be encouraged to gather on Friday evenings or Sunday afternoons for activities organized by the Youth Minister with the assistance of volunteers from the parish.

On the change of Holy Mass times...

Beginning on the first weekend of Advent (November 29/30) and the start of a new church year, there will be a change in the times for Holy Mass. Weekend Masses will be Saturday at 5:00 p.m., Sunday at 9:00 a.m., 10:30 a.m. and Noon. Having celebrated the Sunday 7:00 p.m. Mass from about the middle of October through to the end of April, I observed that attendance remained at a maximum of about 150 people and that this number did not increase. I also observed that we did not attract that many young people at this time. Given the large numbers of people that attend on Sunday morning, I am confident that a Noon Mass will help alleviate some of the overflow and better meet the needs of our growing community than a 7:00 p.m. Mass. At the Noon Mass, young people will be encouraged to participate in the music ministry which will adopt a praise and worship style. It is my hope that the Youth Minister will plan activities so that the young people will gather in the parish hall after the Noon Mass.

I am especially grateful to the members of the Pastoral Advisory Council for their wholehearted supported of these initiatives. I realize that change is not easy but I strongly believe that we need to make a dedicated effort to welcoming young people and offering them a place where they can gather. What Pope Francis said about the church applies to all our efforts at welcoming young people and every individual into this parish family: "The Church must be a place of mercy freely given, where everyone can feel welcomed, loved, forgiven and encouraged to live the good life of the Gospel."

#### On making my annual retreat...

I will be away making my annual retreat this coming week. As a result, Holy Mass will only be offered next Friday at 8:30 a.m. to accommodate the staffs from the 4 parish elementary schools and high school who are having their faith day. Please keep me in your prayers and be assured that you will be remembered in my prayers.
