**THE ROMAN MISSAL • *The Liturgy of the Word***

The Liturgy of the Word will be basically the same with the new translation of the Roman Missal. In Canada the *Sunday Lectionary* (collection of readings) was revised in 2009. The only major change will be our response to the priest’s (or deacon’s) greeting before the Gospel - “The Lord be with you. R. And with your spirit.” The readings for Sunday Mass are based on a three year cycle during which we hear a significant portion of the Bible at Mass. We are currently in “Year A” - the year of Matthew. In Advent we will begin “Year B” and hear mainly Mark’s Gospel at Sunday Mass.
