Sacramental Information

Baptism - Infants and young children of parishioners are baptized on Sunday afternoons, except during the Season of Lent. Marriage - Weddings for parishioners are generally celebrated on Saturday afternoons. Kindly contact the Pastor a minimum of one year before the desired date of marriage. Preparation is provided in the Parish.

SACRAMENTAL REGISTRATION

RELIGIOUS INSTRUCTION FOR PUBLIC SCHOOL

Parents of children enrolled in **Public** or **Private** schools are invited to enroll them in our parish's religious instruction program. The lessons are home-based and children work at their grade level and their own pace. It is sponsored by the Diocese of Hamilton and administrated through our parish. The successful completion of the appropriate Grade Levels is required prior to the child's reception of the Sacraments. For example a child in Grade 2 should have completed the Level 1 program and be enrolled in Level 2. A child preparing for Confirmation should have completed all levels (and enrolled in Level 7 or 8) prior to Confirmation. For more information and registration kindly contact the Parish Office. PARISH FINANCIAL SUPPORT (July 2012)

In the month of July, we received financial contributions from 628 families/households out of 3,112 registered contributors. Of those contributions 29% were \$20 or more and provided 62% of the income for the parish; 213 contributions (or 30% of the total) gave \$10 or less.

We are very appreciative of the generous support of our parish during the summer months - particularly when so many are away. As September begins please consider giving to the parish. If you currently contribute \$5 per week (and you are gainfully employed or have a steady income) might you consider an increase to \$7.50 or \$10 per week. Even a small increase like that can make a big difference to the parish. Your contributions help the parish further its work of ministry and also supports the parish plant and mortgage. The Parish's *Building Fund* continues to receive donations on the 2nd Sunday of each month and 100% of those donations goes to our parish debt. Other donations to the parish - ie regular Sunday offerings - are assessed by the Diocese at 11%.
