Marriage - Weddings for parishioners are generally celebrated on Saturday afternoons. Kindly contact the Pastor a minimum of one year before the desired date of marriage. Preparation is provided in the Parish.

The Roman Missal The Introductory Rites

These simple gestures, songs and prayers draw us into the Eucharistic liturgy. We come here from our homes and our busy lives to encounter the Risen Lord who

strengthens and nourishes our faith so that we can be his disciples in the world. The gathering song is carefully chosen by the music ministers to echo the Word of God we will soon hear. The *Sign of the Cross* reminds us of the central mystery of our faith - the suffering, death and resurrection of Jesus Christ. We are *greeted* by the presiding priest using the age-old greetings of the Apostles. Our response - *And with your spirit* - acknowledges the priest's role as standing *in personna Christi* leading us in prayer. We invoke God's mercy in the *Penitential Act* and these leads us to offer our praise as we sing, *Glory to God in the highest, and on earth peace to people of good will ...* The presiding priest then offers the *Collect* or opening prayer which collects all our prayers and offers them in one to the Father, through Christ Jesus, in the unity of the Holy Spirit.
