CATECHESIS OF THE GOOD SHEPHERD - ATRIUM

It's that time of year again. The Holy Cross Catechesis of the Good Shepherd would like to invite all parents with children ages 3 through 12 to register with our program. What is Catechesis of the Good Shepherd? It is a faith based child friendly program based on Maria Montessori style of learning. The child is presented with material and parables from the bible at their level. There are three levels: level 1 ages 3-6, level 2 ages 6-9, level 3 ages 9-12. Ideally the child would spend 3 years in each level there by building their relationship with Jesus through the use of the materials available. There is also a Sacramental preparation component for those children preparing for their Reconciliation and First Holy Communion and for those receiving their Confirmation. The program runs after school from October through May. We begin on Tuesday, October 13th. Level 1 Tuesdays from 4:15 - 5:30 p.m.; Level 2 Wednesdays from 4:30 - 6:30 p.m.; and Level 3 on Tuesdays from 5:45 - 7:45 p.m. The fee is \$50 per child for supplies and upkeep of materials. We look forward to nourishing your child with the words of Jesus with the Holy Spirit as our teacher and guide.
