Sacramental Information

Baptism - Infants and young children of parishioners are baptized on Sunday afternoons, except during the Season of Lent. Marriage - Weddings for parishioners are generally celebrated on Saturday afternoons. Kindly contact the Pastor a minimum of one year before the desired date of marriage. Preparation is provided in the Parish.

Arrangements can be made for the *Sacrament of the Sick* and for *Holy Communion*. RELIGIOUS INSTRUCTION FOR PUBLIC SCHOOL

Parents of children enrolled in <u>Public</u> or <u>Private</u> schools are invited to enroll them in our parish's religious instruction program. The lessons are home-based and children work at their grade level and their own pace. It is sponsored by the Diocese of Hamilton and administrated through our parish. The successful completion of the appropriate Grade Levels is **required** prior to the child's reception of the Sacraments. For example a child in Grade 2 should have completed the Level 1 program and be enrolled in Level 2. A child preparing for Confirmation should have completed all levels (and enrolled in Level 7 or 8) prior to Confirmation. For more information and registration kindly contact the Parish Office. Parents of children in Grade 2 or Grade 7/8 should refer to the additional information regarding the Sacraments (above).

PASTORAL REFERENCES FOR TEACHERS

Most school boards require applicants to provide a "pastoral reference" from their parish priest. These letters are meant to testify to the applicant's practice of the Catholic faith (ie regular attendance at Sunday Mass); their involvement in the life of the parish community; as well as their moral character & way of life. It is difficult to provide such references for individuals who do not attend Mass regularly and who are not involved in the life of our parish.

YEAR OF FAITH OPENING CELEBRATION



All are invited to the *Opening of the Year of Faith* in the Diocese of Hamilton on Thursday, October 11th at 7:00 p.m. in the Cathedral of Christ the King, Hamilton. The opening of the Year of Faith coincides with the 50th Anniversary of the opening of the Second Vatican Council (1962-1965)

and is meant, by Pope Benedict XVI, to be a year in which Catholics renew and deepen their faith in Christ Jesus and their life in the Church.
