

News from DEVELOPMENT AND PEACE

Today is 'Solidarity Sunday'. "One Human Family, Food for All" Our contributions to DEVELOPMENT AND PEACE go a long way in transforming lives in the Global South.

Ethiopia: 2013—Horn of Africa Drought—Now,2 years after the terrible drought our donations helped change lives there for the better. D&P enabled rapid distribution of food and the launch of long-term projects to help communities resume farming and protect themselves in time of drought, e.g. providing drought -resistant seeds, new farming techniques, etc.

Brazil: D&P partner, CPT supports, trains and organizes farming communities throughout Brazil. Thanks to our financial help, small scale farmers are now producing more consistent yields and even have a market for their products. In addition some farmers are venturing into other related small scale businesses.

D&P is involved with the many poor around the world where poverty and injustice prevail. D&P workers are our hands and feet in the Global South. They need our support to lift people out of poverty and thus profoundly changing their lives.
