

In September 2014 our parish family will welcome Hospitality North. Over the past 12 years this ecumenical gesture of feeding the poor has taken place through a shared ministry with New St. James Presbyterian Church, Holy Trinity Lutheran Church, Colborne St. United Church and St. Michael's Catholic Church. Each week volunteers prepare a meal for approximately 150 people. Over the past 12 years , Holy Trinity Lutheran hosted the meal for 5 years and New St. James Presbyterian for the past 7 years. We have taken up the call and for the next number of years, each Monday a meal will be prepared.

The first Monday a meal will be prepared by St. Michael's; the second Monday by Colborne St., the third Monday by Trinity Lutheran & the fourth Monday by New St. James.
