

#### Parish Offertory Envelopes for 2012 - Note Changes

To reduce mailing costs, the Parish has decided to issue Offertory envelopes once a year, replacing the 4 times a year mailing process.

Please try to make every effort to use the newly assigned envelope number on Jan 1, 2012 envelopes and thereafter. During the transition, it would helpful if people would write their name and address on all donation envelopes during the Christmas and early 2012 months. This will ensure proper recording for tax receipts.


