

"After John had been arrested, Jesus came to Galilee proclaiming the gospel of God...." - Mark 1:14

It must have taken great love and trust for Jesus to do what the Father had sent Him here on earth to do. In the same way, following a life of stewardship takes great love and trust from us. We must be willing to surrender completely to God, trusting that God will always give us all that we need to fulfill His plan for us.
