

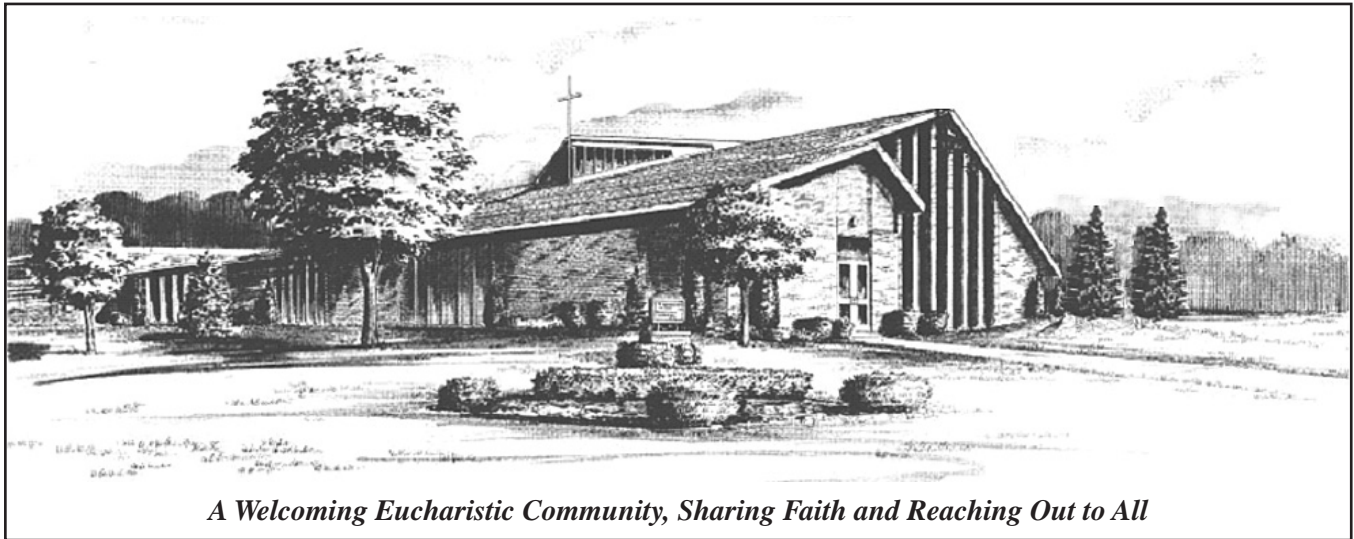

### Knights Table

**The Family Fully Alive** -The foundation of the domestic church is the sacrament of marriage. It is therefore important to reflect often on the mystery and calling of this sacrament-Meditation, from a homily by St John Chrysostom.

How is marriage a mystery? The two have become one. This is not an empty symbol. They have not become the image of anything on earth, but of God himself. They come to be made into one body. See the mystery of love. If the two do not become one, they cannot increase; they can increase only by decreasing.

How great is the strength of unity.

1. Do we think of marriage differently when we remember that Christ is present in the sacrament of marriage? Does this change or challenge our personal views of love?

2. What do we think of St. John Chrysostom's principle of Christian married love, that spouses and family increase by decreasing?

Scripture Reading – Psalm 128, A prayer of the happy home that follows the Lord.

**Family Project:** - Parents, share memories about your wedding day with your family, have your children share one thing each they appreciate about their parents' marriage. Each spouse should share one reason they are grateful for their marriage and how each sees Christ as present in their marriage.
