

In this anniversary year marking 500 years since the reformation in Germany (1517) the London congregations of the Evangelical Lutheran Church in Canada (ELCIC) and some of their close neighbouring parishes in the Catholic Diocese of London, are being intentional about extending the bridges of Christian fellowship between our two communities.

We started our joint work by sharing the live video feed of the service held in Lund, Sweden, on 31st October, when Pope Francis and Lutheran World Federation President, Bishop Dr. Munib Younan, led the commemorative service marking the start of this 500th anniversary year.
