

#### Parish Pastoral Council Meeting - Parking

A question concerning parking at the Church was raised.

- Legally the Church has only 5 parking spaces, 3 of which are designated as handicap spaces.
- The rest of the parking spaces belong to St. Michael's School. Please keep in mind that during the week the parking is limited. There can be no double parking as it prevents teachers and school staff from getting to their afternoon job locations.
- 3. We must observe the fire lanes in case of emergency.
- 4. We only park in the handicap areas if we are in need of it.
- 5. Lane between the School and Church is an EXIT ONLY lane. Entrance to parking is between the Rectory and Church Lane.
