

- Work on a viable Mass schedule for our Family.
- Personnel plan will be developed through discussions with staff and team members.
- Office location will be decided.
- Financial plan will be developed

Let us pray to the Holy Spirit and to our patron saints as we plan to activate our Family of Parishes in July. May our good God bless us abundantly as we continue this journey in faith.


