Important Update: The HVAC installation is not the only significant improvement being made here at the Church. In response to the past acts of vandalism and to continue to ensure the security of staff, parishioners and property; the Finance Committee has approved the installation of a security system in the Parish. This security system will include protection of entry into the building, alarm response for break-in and fire as well as video coverage of outside areas of the building. For disclosure purposes, please note that cameras will now be recording activity on the South side of the building as well as the entry lane and parking lot to the East side of St. Michael's School. We hope that these measures will guard against any unwanted entry into the building, acts of vandalism or theft from some of the parking areas. On an additional note of importance, any entry by the public after 4 pm on weekdays will be through the use of a new doorbell located at the automatic entrance door at the North-East area of the Narthex. If there are scheduled meetings or events outside of office hours, regular entry will continue as it always has. Capital Corner – The next phase in our Capital work, the construction of the new HVAC system for the Church will begin next week. This will mean a significant change in the weekday routine of the Parish.
