

Youth Walking Pilgrimage August 19-22

Young adults ages 18-35 are especially invited to participate in a twoday pilgrimage in the footsteps of the Canadian Martyrs' leading up to our Diocesan Mass at the Martyrs Shrine, Midland, Ontario, on August 22 with Bishop Fabbro and Dabrowski. The pilgrimage will begin at the Martyrs Shrine with an evening vigil, on Sunday, August 20. Monday morning we will visit Ste-Marie-among-the-Hurons and then head to the St. Louis mission and walk approx. 6kms to St. Ignace, the site of the martyrdom of St. Jean de Brébeuf and St. Gabriel de Lalement, where we will camp for the evening.
