



Baptism is the sacrament that is the gateway to all the other sacraments. Baptism is necessary for salvation. By the gift of baptism people are freed from sins, born again as a child of God and made like Christ and made members of the Church.

It is with great reverence that Baptism is received and celebrated. Out of this reverence, then as a Parish we are making some requirements of those asking for Baptism. There must be an understanding of the sacrament; a) must be attending mass each Sunday, b) must attend a baptismal preparation course. Once those requirements are met a Baptismal date for celebrating the sacrament will be picked.
