

Youth Walking Pilgrimage August 19-22

Young adults ages 18-35 are especially invited to participate in a two-day pilgrimage in the footsteps of the Canadian Martyrs' leading up to our Diocesan Mass at the Martyrs Shrine, Midland, Ontario, on August 22 with Bishop Fabbro and Dabrowski. The pilgrimage will begin at the Martyrs Shrine with an evening vigil, on Sunday, August 20.
