

Stewardship Reflection

"Why spend your money for what is not bread; your wages for what fails to satisfy?" - Isaiah 55:2

Do you waste the financial gifts that God has given you on things that are not necessary or on things that do not give you joy and fulfillment? This is Isaiah's challenge to us this week.

R.C.I.A. (Rites of Christian Initiation for Adults)

Building Updates

The bidding for the Hall Roof have come in and a contract has been signed with Smith-Peat Roofing - for a cost of \$160,000. We received 4 bids and this was the lowest.

The replacement of the Hall Roof will take place as soon as possible.

The Kitchen work is currently in the process of being finalized. We need to raise about \$60,000 more than we have already raised.

The next major project is to cover the cost of the heating/air conditioning for the Church, which is approximately \$200,000.

Fr. Biju John

On Friday July 8th, 2011, Bishop Fabbro appointed Fr. Biju John as Associate Pastor of St. Michael's Parish. Fr. Biju John is a Diocesan Priest of the Archdiocese of Changancherry in Kerala, India. He was ordained April 16, 1998. In 2002 Fr. Biju was asked to go to England where he received a Doctorate in Information Technology. There he worked with Cardinal Murphy O'Connor in the Archdiocese of Westminster.

Parking Lot

The London District Catholic School Board has repaved the playground and parking area. It is truly a gift from them to us.

Let us ponder how fortunate we are that the School Board allows us to use their property. Please be aware that the black chain link fence that runs along the south of the church is the property line between the church and the school.

During the months when school is in we need to respect the school staff and their need for parking and freedom to go in and out of the parking lot.

As you know, there have been many changes in Hospital Procedures, including Pastoral Care. As a Catholic, when you are admitted to the hospital you need to request the services of the Priest for a visit or Blessing of the Sick through the Pastoral Care Department. Each of the hospitals in London has a Chaplain assigned to them by the Bishop.
