Update re: Canada Summer Jobs Program

In February, Bishop Fabbro wrote to all the faithful of the Diocese of London and announced that we, as a diocese, would take a stand against the federal government's position on applicants for the Canada Summer Jobs Grant program having to make an attestation with regard to "reproductive rights". Many across the country joined in this protest, and also refused grant money. We were supported across the Diocese (and from outside) with an extraordinary collection that allowed us to meet the needs of past applicants and others as well.

It is time to write to Members of Parliament to demand that this attestation be withdrawn for applicants, on the basis of freedom of conscience and religion as guaranteed in the Charter of Rights. The policies of the government of the day cannot override the guarantees in the Charter! All the faithful are encouraged to write to his or her MP and make their opinion known. Personal letters are the most effective (i.e., [name], House of Commons, Ottawa, Ontario, K1A 0A6 – and postage is free to MPs), but one may choose to click on www.savesummerjobs.ca to facilitate sending a letter. As always, such letters should be polite; they should be brief and to the point to be most effective.

It is to be hoped that the Government will listen to the voices of the people and relinquish the abhorrent attestation.

Merlin Walking Pilgrimage

Bishop Fabbro and Bishop Dabrowski invite the faithful to celebrate the Solemnity of the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary at the Diocesan Shrine of Our Lady of the Rosary in Merlin on Wednesday, August 15, 2018. Bishop Fabbro will celebrate Mass at 11 o'clock, followed by lunch. Prior to the Mass, the Sacrament of Reconciliation will be offered. After lunch, a Rosary Procession will take place, followed by Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament at 2:15 pm. The faithful can also join a walking pilgrimage to the Shrine. There will be two starting points for the pilgrimage; a 10 KM walk will depart from the North Buxton Museum at 8:00 am, and a 5 KM walk will depart from the Merlin Community Hall at 9:00 am. Pilgrims arriving by car will be able to park their vehicles at these locations, and volunteers will be available after the day's celebrations to drive pilgrims back to the parking lots. A diocesan representative will be at each of the two departure locations and will lead pilgrims to the Shrine. Pilgrims are welcome to bring their own lunches, or purchase a hamburger or hotdog from the Knights of Columbus for a small fee. It is not necessary to register for this celebration.
