The Society of Saint Vincent de Paul

Annual Collection for St. Vincent de Paul and Emergency Assistance Program - In past years St. Michael's has promoted a special collection that directly benefitted 2 community programs. Proceeds were shared between SVDP and THAW. This year, half of the funds taken up will be shared between SVDP and The Emergency Utility Assistance Program which is a year-round program that provides emergency financial relief to London families living in poverty to avoid the disconnection of electric and gas services. It receives funding from the City of London, London Hydro, Union Gas, Sisters of St. Joseph and other community donors. About 13% of the applicants are living in the St. Michael's Parish area. The major reasons for requiring assistance are higher than expected utility costs, unexpected expenses, job loss and variable income. Sadly, there is a noticeable increase in low income households in need of energy assistance. Contribution envelopes along with a more detailed report of the work of these crucial organizations will be found in your bulletin the weekend of June 17 & 18.
