Today we celebrate the Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity. The idea of one God Who is Three Persons is an amazing mystery indeed. Surely, as we try to wrap our heads around the idea of the Trinity, we might look to Jesus' description of His union with the Father or His sending of the Spirit as a starting point. The notion of the Trinity contains four truths: (1) In one Divine Nature

there are three persons, the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit. (2) No one of the persons is either of the other, each is wholly Himself. (3) The Father is God, the Son is God, and the Holy Spirit is God. (4) They are not three Gods but one God. We should not make this mystery a mathematical reality. We cannot just say Three equals One and move on. The communion, community and love found in the Trinity become a reality for the way God intends us to love one another. God so loved the world that he sent his Son to lead all of us in love to everlasting life. This Trinity Sunday the gospel talks about God's love for us. You see, the mystery of the Trinity is not about math - Three in One, One in Three - but about love. The message could hardly be more direct: The way to know God is through comprehending God's love for the world made visible in the Son. As a community of believers, we surrender ourselves to one another in love, and in this imitation of God's inner life of mutual self-emptying, we participate in the Trinity. Think about it. Whenever we gather to celebrate, we gather because of love. Life itself is preparing us for an eternity in the community of God Who is love. Our Family of Parishes will be activated in July. Our Transition Team continues to meet as we move toward the July 4th implementation of Our Family. Please keep the parish staff and the Transition Team in your prayers. Change can be a difficult and challenging experience. Let's make this momentous change in our history a blessing and an opportunity for real Spiritual growth. 


