

The Canadian Conference of Catholic Bishops and the Canadian Catholic Organization for Development and Peace have announced a joint campaign to respond to the serious food shortage and drought in the Sahel region of West Africa. 15 million people face food shortages and malnutrition. Development and Peace, in partnership with Caritas Internationalis and its emergency programs, is helping local Western African community groups cope with the effects of the food crisis, by supporting large-scale food distribution projects. 
