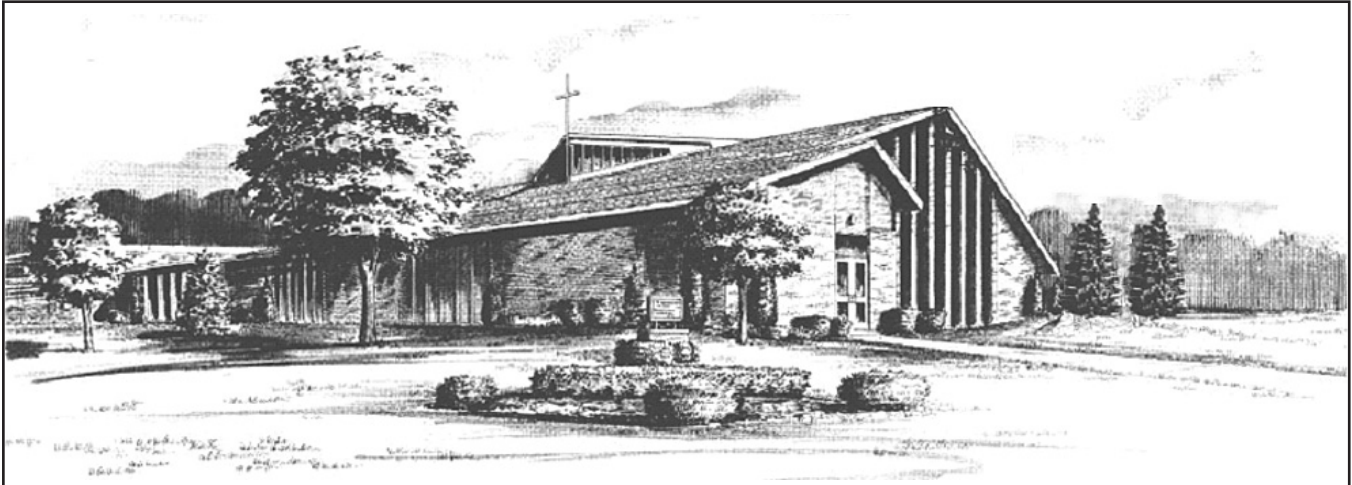

He is still an animated little boy who taught me the Arabic phrase! Come in and peace. I am very proud of this!

Thank you to everyone and also the Ivey colleagues who have provided ongoing support, with donations of a baby crib for the baby expected on June 29. Mahmoud is taking his driving test on June 22 and will continue with ESL at a community program with the two older boys in July. We are working on volunteer opportunities and job leads as possible within the Ontario works program.
