

# WORLD YOUTH DAY

World Youth Day, WYD, is a yearly youth celebration in Rome that was started by Pope John Paul II in 1984 as a way to inspire the youth and encourage them in living the teachings of Christ. The first international WYD took place in Buenos Aires, Argentina in 1987. It is now tradition that every three years, WYD is hosted in a different country. Youth from many nations around the globe, come together showing the universality and diversity within the Catholic Church. It is a time for youth to share their faith and be rejuvenated to spread the gospel of Jesus Christ in their homelands. It is also a way to come to understand other cultures and spread peace and understanding throughout the world. This year World Youth Day will be held in Madrid, Spain and the theme is "Rooted and built up in Jesus Christ, firm in the faith" (cf Colossians 2:7)

There are currently 13 youth between the ages of 17-23 and 4 adult chaperones from our parish who are preparing for the pilgrimage to Madrid in 2011. Over the last year we have been busy fundraising towards the cost of our flights, food and accomodations. Each pilgrim is responsible for paying \$2,400 in US dollars. So far, we have raised funds through bake sales, breakfasts, car washes, a yard sale and some individual donations. As of our last bake sale and raffle on April9/10, 2011 we have raised \$13, 700 in total (in Canadian dollars). Our goal is to raise half of the pilgrim's cost which is approximately \$1,200 per pilgrim for a total of \$19,200.

If you would like to make a personal donation to the pilgrims, you may place your donation in an envelope and mark it "World Youth Day." We are very grateful for the generosity of the parish thus far. We continue to keep you in our prayers.
