Today is Pentecost Sunday, the 50th day since Easter Sunday. This day marks the end of the Easter Season. We were reminded last week that Jesus did not leave us alone when He ascended to the Father. He sent us the Holy Spirit. In our first reading from the Acts of the Apostles we learn that the Holy Spirit came to the disciples when they were gathered together in one place.
