Dear Members of St. Michael's Parish,

In the bulletin this weekend is an envelope for the Building Fund. I am asking you to help us meet the costs that come with the repairs to our building. The church was built in 1970 and since then there has been basically no major building issues. However after 41 years the reality has hit, we need to do some work on the structure.

Avis Contractors gave us a building audit and named areas that need repair. The roof on the entire 70 year old structure needs to be replaced. The furnace and air conditioning units, the kitchen and washroom facilities. They figure the cost for all this is \$1.5 million. We have had ongoing problems with the heating and air conditioning in the church and over the past six weeks we have tried to find the problem: It is now evident we need to replace the whole system. This is an additional \$200,000.

We need to raise, in the next year, \$450,000 to do what the Diocese has given us permission to carry out this year.

Please Be as Generous As You Can. We need all of us to Help.
