

March 5th our catechumens will celebrate the Rite of Election at the 5 p.m. mass where they will take on the new title

of 'Elect'. Their names will be entered into the Book of Elect as both Church and catechumen affirm that God has called these individuals to the sacraments of initiation at the Easter Vigil. This marks the beginning of the Period of Purification and Enlightenment, a more intense time of preparation that focuses on interior reflection and transformation. It is the final leg of the journey to the font of Baptism, oils of Confirmation and the banquet feast of Holy Eucharist where we are united as one family in Christ.

We the baptised practice the disciplines of Lent; prayer, fasting and almsgiving alongside our elect as we prepare to renew our Baptismal promises and grow in God's grace and love.
