

#### **Stewardship Reflection**

#### "Jesus said to her, 'Give me a drink." - John 4:7

How often through our lives does Jesus ask us to give Him a drink? Remember that Jesus lives in every person who is physically hungry and thirsty and also in all those who thirst for compassion, love or care. Mother Teresa was motivated in her work in Calcutta by two of Our Lord's last words as He hung on the cross. "I thirst" - John 19:28 Sometimes it may be difficult for us to give the drink that Jesus asks from us. Yet, can we really refuse to share our time, talent or treasure to relieve Our Lord's thirst in this world?

#### Triduum Celebrations

The three Days of Easter are treated as one day. The celebration of Holy Thursday, Good Friday and Holy Saturday are about our faith: these days flow into each other. Please make every effort to celebrate Holy Thursday 7:30 pm, Good Friday 3:00 pm and the greatest celebration of all, Holy Saturday 9:00 pm

<u>Palm Sunday - April 16<sup>th</sup> - 7:00 pm</u> Taizé Prayer, the Newman and Sunday 12:30 pm Choir will lead in song a time of Taizé Prayer. Taizé Prayer is a time of reflection, scripture and song. The evening prayer will focus on the gift of the Eucharist.

<u>"Return to me with all your heart" - Third Sunday of Lent</u>
This Sunday, our Elect (those seeking to be initiated at the Easter Vigil), will stand before us asking for God's mercy and help as they proceed through their Lenten retreat. In preparation for this First Scrutiny they have pondered the grace they need to abandon all that keeps them from relationship with Christ. The Prayer of Intercession will cry out very specifically for that which they long: to drink deeply of the living water, to slough off consumerism, to speak out of integrity, to be courageous in witnessing to their new found joy, etc As the Elect move intensely through the Lenten period, they indeed become witnesses for us of the depth that is possible in the conversion process. Let their witness strengthen us in our prayer and reflection. Invite the Lord to pour clean water over each of us and wash away our sins. Remember that on April 6 the Sacrament of Penance will be available all day in our parish. The schedule for this "all-day confessions" event is from 8:30 am to 8:30 pm on Wednesday, April 6<sup>th</sup>, 2011.


