

### Climate Change: What is our responsibility as Catholics?

The St. Michael's Social Justice Committee invites you to attend an evening of education and action on Climate Change on **Thurs Nov 19<sup>th</sup> at 7 pm** in the parish hall. The evening will start with a presentation by Caterina Lindman on the topic of global climate change, Pope Francis' teaching on the subject, and actions that we can take at both a personal and political level. Caterina Lindman is a member of the Citizen's Climate Lobby, a frequent contributor to the Waterloo Region Record newspaper on the subject of climate change, and is an internationally-invited speaker on the topic. Following the presentation, you will be welcome to partake in a letter-writing campaign and workshop led by the Social Justice Committee.
