**An invitation from Bishop Fabbro to all parishioners and friends:**

Almost daily news stories appear in the media related to end of life issues. These stories usually have to do with the conversation happening in the public square about a person's choice when and how they will die. Our faith has much to contribute to this conversation. In order to assist people of faith entering into this conversation with their families and friends, I have invited Dr. Moira McQueen, executive director of the Canadian Catholic Bioethics Institute to present a workshop that will address issues such as the death and dying process, our choices and options, and the state of the conversation on euthanasia and assisted suicide. Workshops will take place from 7 pm – 9 pm on Nov 4, 2014 at St. George, London and Nov 5, 2014 at Holy Name of Jesus, Essex. There is no charge to attend.
