



It has been the long standing practice of the Church that the parish in which you worship on Sundays determines where the sacraments are celebrated, and it is enshrined in the Church's Canon Law. The participation in masses organized through the schools does not mean that your family is registered at any particular parish. Your family and children need to be registered parishioners at the parish you want to receive their sacraments. If you have not received the Thanksgiving mail out, you are NOT registered at St. Michael's Parish or your mailing address is not current in our files.

THE SACRAMENT OF CONFIRMATION

What is Confirmation? This is the Sacrament in which the Holy Spirit comes to us in a special way to unite us more closely to Jesus and the Father, strengthening us in our responsibilities of service, leadership and spreading the Word of God.

Who can receive this Sacrament? The Sacrament is open to anyone who is in Grade Eight or older and has already received Baptism, Eucharist and Reconciliation. The Church asks each candidate to spend a significant period of time preparing themselves by praying, attending Sunday Mass, studying and serving within the community.

How do I go about registering? Registration forms have been mailed out to all registered parishioners in grade eight. There will also be additional forms available in the main foyer.
