

#### Canonization of Br. André of Montreal

Oct 17th, 2010 marked a significant event in the Church of Canada. Pope Benedict XVI raised to the ranks of the Saints the first Canadian born male Saint Br. Andre of Montreal. He was a man who suffered physically all of his life. At his birth he was so frail his parents had him baptized immediately because they thought he would die within days. He was ill all of his life. His father died before he was eight and his mother died before he turned ten. He was raised by an aunt. In 1867 he entered the Holy Cross Community and served as janitor and the "Door Keeper". In his service he met many and heard of their pain. He prayed with them and through the Intercession of St. Joseph asked for their healing. He was known as Miracle Worker. He dreamt and fulfilled his dream by building a church to honor St. Joseph. The Oratory of St. Joseph in Montreal is a testament to his faith. St. Joseph is the patron saint of Canada.
