



The transport of Holy Communion from the Altar of the Mass has been a long standing tradition dating back to the early days of Christianity in Rome. All who carry Holy Communion from St. Michael's Church have the Pastor's permission, have had a Police Background check, and have been appropriately instructed. Non-parishioners who carry consecrated hosts from St. Michael's do so only with Fr. Murray's permission and the knowledge of their own Pastor. Holy Communion is transported in a pyx and is taken the same day to its destination, it may not be reserved in private homes overnight. Our parishioners often express their deep gratitude for those who bring them Holy Communion when they cannot come to Mass. 
