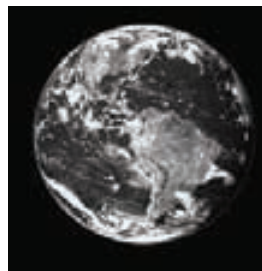

Central themes in recent Church teaching on the environment:

“1. Human Beings are Creatures Made in God’s Image.” Human beings are part of the natural world, yet simultaneously transcend it.

There are two key elements here: (1) human beings are creatures, i.e., we are not God. We are therefore not to act with god-like domination over the rest of creation, but rather to recognize that creation comes to us as a gift from our Creator. (2) Unique among creatures, we are created in God’s image, and therefore bear an inestimable dignity.
