The Parishioners of St. Elizabeth Mourn the Death of Former Pastor, Fr. Donald Tuori Nov. 20, 1948 - Aug. 6, 2016 Ordained Sept. 18, 1976 Pastor, St Elizabeth Parish, 2005 -2012

Fr. Don was born in Syracuse, New York. He studied at the University of Waterloo, Saint-

Paul University, University of Ottawa and Queen Mary's College in London, England. He served the people of God at the parishes of St. Martin de Porres, St. Michael's in Corkery, St. Peter Celestine in Pakenham, and in the Ottawa parishes of Resurrection of Our Lord, St. Augustine, St. Philip, Holy Cross, Our Lady of Perpetual Help and St. Elizabeth. He served as Regional Vicar for various pastoral regions of the English sector and as chaplain at Riverside Hospital and at the Children's Hospital. He was involved in ecumenical work with the Church of England, the Episcopal Church of the United States and the Anglican Church of Canada. Since 2015. Fr. Don served as the Parochial Administrator at St. Ignatius parish. May he rest peacefully in the Lord.
