TWO CANADIAN HOLY PEOPLE REMEMBERED THIS WEEK

Blessed André Grasset was born in Montréal in 1758 and martyred in Paris, France in 1792 during the French Revolution. He was martyred for refusing to swear an oath against

the Church. His feast is celebrated on September 2.

Blessed Dina Bélanger who was born in Québec City in 1897, died in the convent in Sillery, 1929. An accomplished musician, teacher and revered mystic, she died in 1929 from tuberculosis. Her feast is celebrated on September 4.
