# Archbishop Damphousse's Christmas Season Lockdown Message:

In a short time, Christians around the world will be celebrating the birth of Jesus Christ. In the

message of the angel to the shepherds in the field we hear these profoundly relevant words once more: "Do not be afraid; for see—I am bringing you good news of great joy for all the people: to you is born this day in the city of David a Saviour, who is the Messiah,\* the Lord" (Lk 2. 10-11).

We are blessed to be able to celebrate the birth of Jesus Christ our Saviour on the 24th and 25th of December in our parishes under our current pandemic protocols, safeguarding the health of our parish families. I want to thank the priests, deacons, religious and lay staff and dedicated parishioner volunteers for your efforts these past months to make it possible to celebrate the Eucharist in our parishes. In Christ we are united and strong!


