St. Scholastica was the twin sister of St. Benedict of Nursia, founder of the Benedictine Order. It was said that she was consecrated to God at her birth, but continued to live at home until her brother founded his monastery at Monte Cassino. She then, in turn,

established a convent in the nearby town of Plombariola. In her writings to Mother Flavia, Saint Scholastica reveals that it was her brother who named her, saying that she was 'destined to remain the in school of the Lord's service." Scholastica is a patron saint of religious sisters and of those seeking protection against violent storms.
