Pope Francis and New Year's Resolutions:



1. Don't gossip. (It's one of our hobbies. For Pope Francis, it's also one of the most evil activities.)

2. Finish your meals.

("Throwing food away is like stealing from the tables of the poor, the hungry!")

3. Make time for others. (Fr. Martin, who received a personal letter from Pope Francis, says: "If the Pope can find time to be kind to others, if he can pause to say thank you, if he can take a moment make someone feel appreciated, then so can I. So can we.")

4. Choose the 'more humble' purchase. (Take it from the Vatican's head of state who rides a 29-year-old Renault.)

5. Meet the poor 'in the flesh.' (Commitment to the poor, the Pope says, must be "person to person, in the flesh.")

6. Stop judging others. (In the same way he denounces gossip, Pope Francis condemns prejudice.)

7. Befriend those who disagree. (Pope Francis surprised Mario Palmaro, a traditionalist who wrote the article, 'The Reason Why We Don't Like This Pope.'" "He just wanted to tell me that he is praying for me," says Palmaro, who is gravely ill.)

8. Make commitments, such as marriage. (Don't be afraid to say "forever.")

9. Make it a habit to 'ask the Lord.' ("Dear young people," Pope Francis says, "some of you may not yet know what you will do with your lives. Ask the Lord, and he will show you the way.")

10. Be happy. (The true Christian, says the Pope, exudes great joy. He says keeping this joy to ourselves "will make us sick in the end.")
